Indonesia Should Speed Up Its Coal Retirement Program to **Support Energy Transition**

Indonesia is struggling to prove its commitment to boost renewable energy. While the government's latest national electricity plan (RUPTL) promotes a much higher portion of renewable energy, coal is still projected to be the primary source of power (59.4%) by the end of decade.

And instead of accelerating the renewable energy transition, the government plans to ban coal exports to keep its coal fleet running.

The decision seems to contradict Indonesia's plan to provide more green energy in the future. It's also causing geopolitical tension.



Energy Drink by PYC Ep. 24 – What is 'Just Transition'? (Feat. Prof. Raphael Heffron)






ITB Energy Innovation Competition

PERWATUSI and PYC Care for Flood Victims



Perkumpulan Warga Tulang Sehat Indonesia (PERWATUSI) dan Purnomo Yusgiantoro Center (PYC)

Perkumpulan Warga Tulang Sehat Indonesia (PERWATUSI) and Purnomo Yusgiantoro Center (PYC) went to the flood location in Serang, Banten, to make donations to flood victims on Tuesday, 8 March 2022. Flash floods that hit Serang, Banten caused by heavy rain on 1 March 2022 had caused the Cibanten River to overflow until the flood level reached two meters.

PERWATUSI and PYC provided donations in the form of basic necessities and some clothes for the victims.

Quoted from *liputan6*, the flood submerged around 2,413 houses and caused 3,500 residents to evacuate. Heavy rain on the night of 28 February until 1 March 2022, caused the Sindangheula dam to overflow and run to the Cibanten River that passed through the city center, residents' villages, and its upstream was on the Karangantu Beach, Kasemen, Serang City, Banten.


Peringatan 73th Serangan Umum 1 Maret 1949: "Patriot Bangsa Menegakkan Kedaulatan Negara"
