A Turning Point for Renewable Energy in Indonesia?

The year 2021 might end up being seen as an important milestone for the development of renewable energy (RE) in Indonesia. So far in this year, the government has issued two important regulations; the energy ministry's Regulation No. 26/2021, concerning the use of rooftop solar power systems, and the Electricity Procurement Plan (RUPTL) for 2021-2030.

These two documents are predicted to facilitate the growth of renewable energy to 23 percent of the nation's energy mix by 2025. One notable point in the new regulation for solar rooftop systems is the ability for customers to export 100 percent of the electricity generated by rooftop solar panels to the state-run power company PLN.

The Importance of the South China Sea: Energy Perspective

Territorial disputes for many countries in the South China Sea have become hot issues for several years until today. The South China Sea, mostly consisting of ASEAN countries and a part of the Asia Pacific region, is currently facing a unilateral claim from China. The dispute is not an intra-ASEAN conflict but involved some ASEAN members; Vietnam, Brunei Darussalam and the Philippines, against China (outside ASEAN) as an aggressive claimant of the South China Sea. Indonesia is also indirectly involved (as a non-claimant state) because fishers from China often engage in Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated Fishing (IUUF) activities in the North Natura Sea – the Indonesian Exclusive Economic Zone.



important role of educational institutions in increasing national oil production and implementing the Industrial Revolution 4.0, and Net Zero Emissions.



The Speakers hope that the book and white paper can give insights to strengthen the sovereignty of the national chemical industry.




